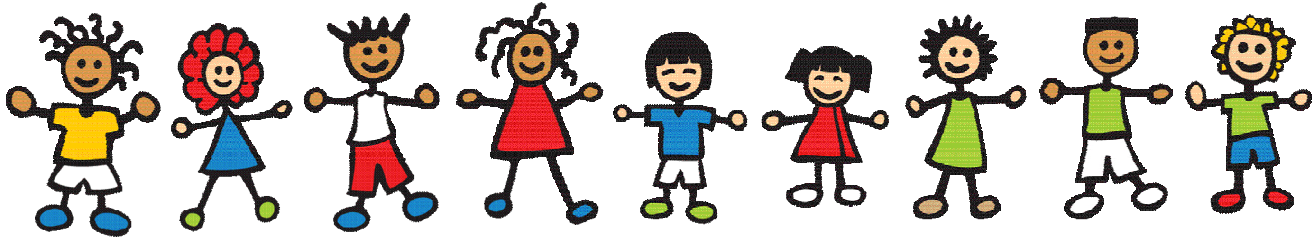

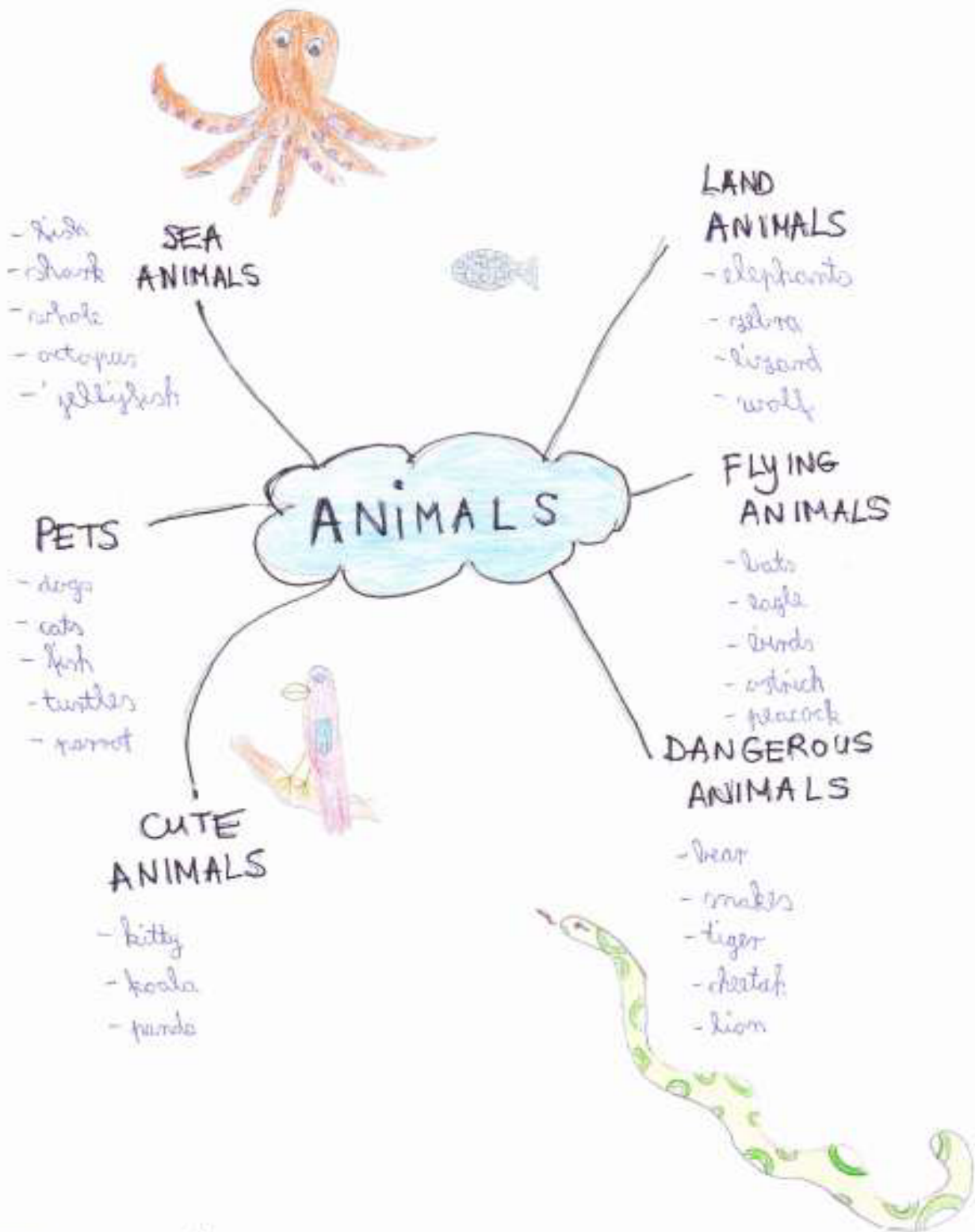


He is 25 inches long. He is 200 g in weight. He lives next to lakes or rivers in North America.

BEARS love eating fish, fruit, plants. They are known to kill larger animals up to the size of a deer. They live in forests or in ZOOS, if they are tamed. One of the species,

the brown bear, is the largest wild animal and the largest predator on the Croatian soil. Every one to four years a female gives birth to a cub. They live in Euroasia, America and Africa. Brown bears are officially protected by law in most European countries.



SQUIRRELS eat berries, fruit, hazelnuts, mushrooms, eggs and young birds. They live in forests, parks, gardens and they are active during the day (sometimes even during the night!). Squirrels are excellent climbers and jumpers. There are only two

kinds of squirrels in Europe – grey and red, with more than 200 known in the world. They hide the food and their young high in spherical nests of the trees. We can't say they hibernate during the entire winter because they occasionally wake-up.

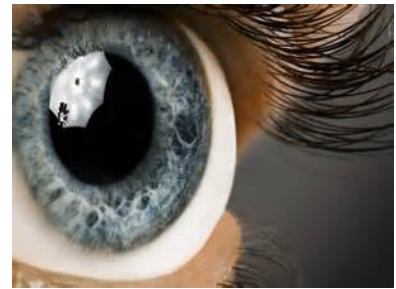

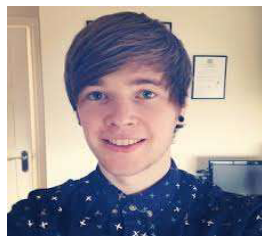
One hour on lakeshore is deadly

Youtuber of the Month!

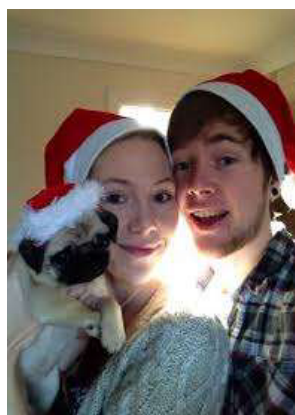


Daniel Middleton (also known as the TheDiamondMinecart) is a very popular Minecraft youtuber that does many Minecraft mods, along with TDM

Vlogs and TDM Plays. He was born on 8th November 1991 in England.



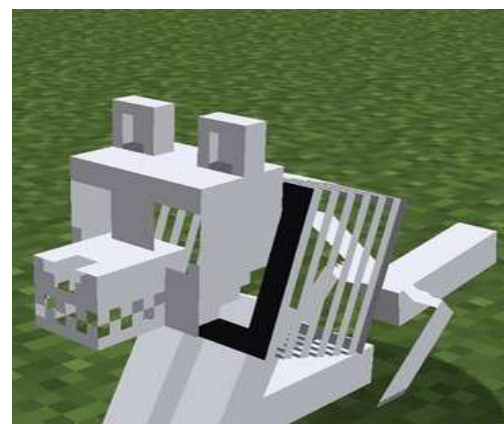
He is considered one of the fastest growing Youtubers to be in YouTube. He has recently reached 3,000,000 subscribers.

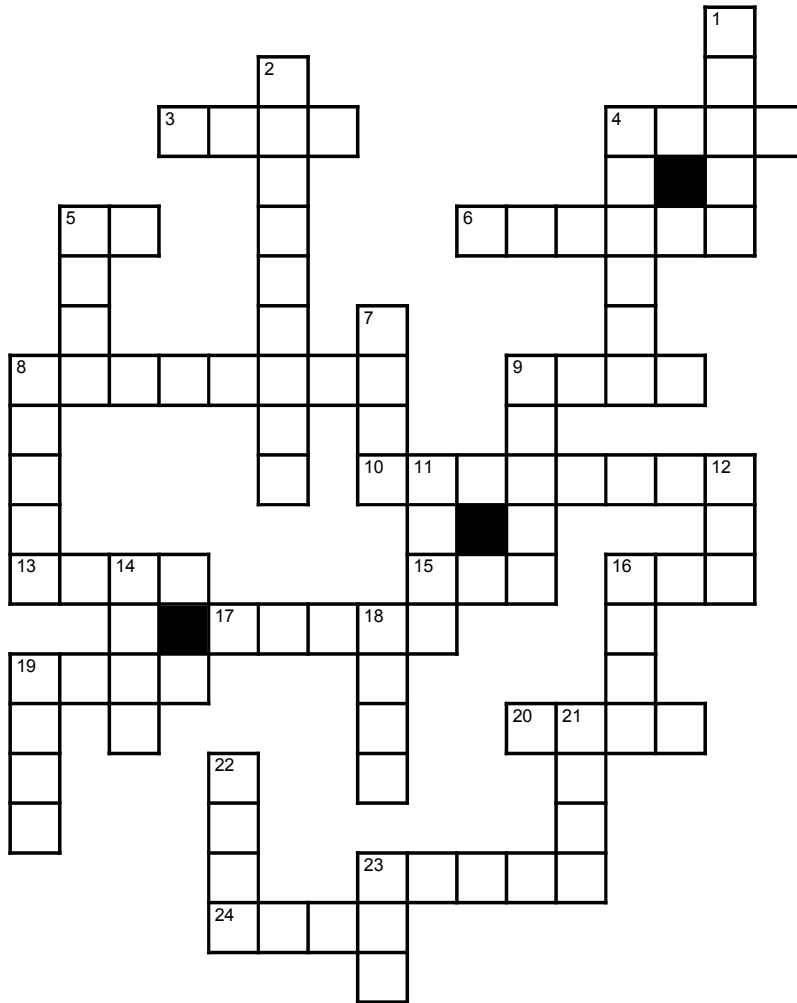
